Reach More: We connected with men's groups at 56 congregations throughout America — hundreds of guys who now share and invest in our vision for every man to be a bold, daring follower of Jesus Christ.

Reach Wide: A group of young men from a variety of backgrounds came together to lay the groundwork for new ways to reach this vital demographic for Christ.

We continue to open many doors to deeper faith, but there's one key that will truly widen that door — to **Reach Generously**. The Disappearance of Christian Men in our World

Consider this...

- What would it be like if there were no men in the church today?
- What if husbands stopped loving their families?
- What if men continue on the path of putting their selfish interests ahead of the interests of others?
- What would become of our future, and the future of our world?
- \rightarrow Only **26%** of men in the US attend church, that number drops for men between the ages of 18-35 $^{\scriptscriptstyle 1}$
- → Fewer than 10% of U.S. churches are able to establish or maintain a vibrant men's ministry.²
- → 90 million men ARE NOT involved in any kind of discipleship. ²
- Fewer than 1% of churchgoing men participate in any sort of ongoing men's ministry program²
- → Each week more than 5 million wives worship without their husbands.³
- ightarrow A report from NPR found that **65%** of men are lonely.

Intentionally Bold Disciples

Vision:

For every man to be a bold, daring follower of Jesus Christ.

Mission:

By God's grace, to intentionally disciple men by personally modeling the character of Jesus by living and leading a lifestyle intended to help transform them from having an inward focus to a culture of naturally loving and serving our neighbors.

Strategic Narrative:

Bathed in Spirit-led prayer, Lutheran Men in Mission (LMM) will disciple men across the spectrum of Lutheranism and the larger Christian church. These men will embody a rich and redemptive representation of the body of Christ in age, ethnicity, theology, and spiritual maturity. All are hungry for God's Word and engaged in an intentional relationship with Jesus Christ.

LMM will build on its distinctive discipleship approach to equipping men to be bold and daring followers of Jesus Christ. Primary funding will come from diverse and dedicated sources, ensuring LMM's sustainability and enabling it to flourish into a strong, God-led future.

Transformational **Discipleship**

LMM Bold Impact (as of March 2023)

- » 4,900+ active men, women and congregations
- » 68,500+ men have been reached by LMM's Bold Impact
- » 25,000+ volunteer hours per year

Bold Gatherings

YouTube: Lutheran Men in Mission

- » A Bold Gathering is an event where men come together to learn, network, and be equipped to BOLDLY live out their faith.
- » Each event features six speakers with varying topics.
- » These events remain available at **boldgathering.com** and on our YouTube channel.

Impact:

- » From 2017-2022, over 860 individuals have participated in a live or streamed event.
- » We have intentionally sought men of diverse racial and ethnic backgrounds as keynote speakers.
- » Since 2017, over 5,250 people have viewed the **Bold Gathering** once posted online after the event.







One Year To Live (OYTL)

- » 44-hour retreat for men with an average of 14 participants per weekend
- » Small Groups: Connection to other men, encouragement, new insights/key learnings
- » Sacred Space: Time in prayer, a time of healing, inner transformation, personal discoveries

Impact:

At year end 2022, over the past 16 years:

- » 2100+ men have attended One Year To Live Retreats
- » 125 attendees per year, on average
- » 170+ retreats have been held
- The Noah's Fund, a scholarship for young adults (20-30 yrs) to attend a One Year To Live Retreat, was established in 2015. In 2022, an additional Scholarship Fund was established for men of all ages.

Project Twelve Initiative

A website where men can find faith-based resources to help answer life's questions.

- » Categories addressed: Growth in You, Growth of Others, Growth of Organization
- Project Twelve seeks to create new and exciting resources for young men regardless of background to help them become the men God is calling them to be.

Impact:

- » In the first half of 2022, over 3,947 individuals accessed **Project Twelve** totaling over 10,653 visits.
- » Over 200 meaningful resources are currently available.
- » Collaborating with seven denominations and other faith groups to expand our resource library
- » 4,800 subscribers receive weekly resources from Project Twelve: projecttwelve.net.
- » Lifelines, a new series of group lessons, is inspired by the men's courses in the Master Builders Bible for Men. So far, two new original sets of 36 lessons each have been written and are available at no cost on projecttwelve.net.
 An additional 36 lessons will debut in the summer of 2023.







Men's Ministry Leadership Guide and Master Builders Bible for Men

The *Master Builders Bible for Men* is a unique version of the Serendipity Bible designed for men. Going beyond the traditional group courses, this version is filled with everything one needs to start a men's ministry, including:

- » A step-by-step leader's guide to starting a Men's Ministry,
- » 200 Bible studies with questions for all levels of study.
- » A how-to guide for building a Men's Ministry program is in the first 32 pages of the *Master Builders Bible for Men* and is available in English and Spanish at **lutheranmeninmission.org**.
- » The Guide mentioned above was created by translating the original into culturally relevant Spanish in November 2019.

Impact:

- » Shared with 290 Spanish-speaking congregations in the ELCA.
- » 68,000+ Master Builders Bible for Men and 25,000 Spanish New Testament Bibles have been distributed.

Reach Boldly:

LMM will capitalize on our unique, distinctive mission.

Outcome: In 2023, LMM will create and implement a marketing/branding plan across all platforms to better reach our audience.

Reach More:

LMM will increase participation in our experiences and use of our resources from our traditional audience.

Outcome: In 2023, LMM will identify, recruit, and equip 50 new volunteers to serve as leaders and/or congregational contacts. Assuming success, this will mean that through these volunteers LMM will reach approximately 350 men who have previously not been part of our ministry.

Reach Wide:

LMM will intentionally reach and disciple younger, more diverse, and unreached men to be bold, daring followers of Jesus Christ.

Outcome: In 2023, LMM will identify, recruit, and equip at least 10 leaders and/or congregational contacts from and for this audience as we intentionally seek to minister to this important demographic.


Reach Generously:


LMM will achieve financial sustainability.



A Legacy of Impact

As you make planned giving decisions, we encourage you to consider a gift to Lutheran Men in Mission. We will make your gift giving experience as simple and as direct as possible. Gifts provide the donor with tax benefits and LMM with critical resources to fulfill our mission.

Ways to Give

Bequests can be arranged through your WILL or LIVING TRUST. They may be for a particular amount, for a specific asset, or for all or a percentage of the residue of your estate. These gifts are deductible for estate tax purposes.

Life insurance policies may be transferred to LMM. You will receive current tax benefits while providing for LMM's future. Often the value of this type of gift will be larger than the amount invested. Leaving retirement plan assets upon death may avoid both income and estate taxes.

A **Charitable Remainder Trust** can be designed to suit a variety of donor situations. The trust distributes funds to LMM only after providing income to you and/or others for life or a term of years. You also receive current tax benefits when the trust is established.

LMM is open to discussing other deferred gift options that might meet your financial needs.

Presidents Legacy Circle

The Presidents Legacy Circle has been established to

- Honor the men who have faithfully led and served Lutheran Men in Mission as its presidents,
- Highlight the men and women who have remembered Lutheran Men in Mission in their Estates and Planned gifts
- Raise awareness to the financial requirements of Lutheran Men in Mission ministry and to generate funding to meet their needs now and into the future
- Lutheran Men in Mission have set an initial goal of \$1 million for declared Estate and Planned gifts.
